TEGNA Wins 83 Regional Edward R. Murrow Awards

MCLEAN, Va.--(BUSINESS WIRE)--Apr. 25, 2018-- TEGNA Inc. (NYSE: TGNA) today won 83 Regional Edward R. Murrow Awards, the most in the company's history and more than any local broadcaster this year. TEGNA won six awards for overall excellence, the highest honor awarded, and nine for excellence in innovation. Murrow Awards are sponsored by the Radio Television Digital News Association (RTDNA) and honor outstanding achievements in electronic journalism.
